**All prices - \$0.50 and \$3.00.**

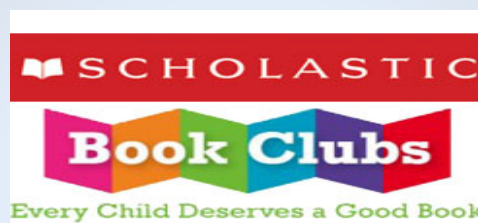


There are heaps of other items to choose from including stationery sets, multi pens, mechanical pencils, and some small gifts/toys.
